APPLICATION FORM

Prospectus and Application Form may be obtained from the School Office on notified working days. The application for admissions on prescribed form will be accepted immediately after the announcements of the class X results of the Meghalaya Board Of School Examination. (MBOSE). All applications must be submitted to the office of the Principal NEHRU Memorial Higher Secondary School Umsning.

Each application must be accompanied by:

- An attested copy of the marksheet of the last examination passed (Class X internet copy will be accepted till the original marksheet is made available.)
- A recent passport size photograph of the student.
- Admit card (xerox copy duly attested)
- Scheduled tribe/caste/OBC certificates (xerox copy duly attested)
- Other relevant documents.

When a student is admitted, he/she needs to submit the following documents:

- Original marksheet of the last examination passed (class X xerox copy duly attested)
- An original transfer certificate from the school last attended
- Other relevant documents.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. All admissions are made as per the rules and regulations of the Meghalaya board of school education and govt. of Meghalaya. Students migrating from any other board must enclose the **Migration Certificate**.
2. Students must always carry the school identity card and produce the same whenever asked for.
3. Students must attend lectures, practicals, tutorials, remedial classes, class tests, and seminars regularly.
4. Students shall keep their parents/guardians informed of their progress in studies. a minimum of 75-80% attendance is required to be eligible to appear in the final examinations.
5. Original medical certificate has to be produced if a student is absent at a stretch for more than 5(five) days along with an application from the parents or guardians clearly stating the reason for absence. forging of parents/guardian's signature by the students is treated as an offence
6. Students must be decently dressed and come to school in prescribed uniform.
7. Smoking, consumption of intoxicants, misuse of mobile phone, eve-teasing and other such misconduct are strictly prohibited.
8. Students are not allowed to loiter unnecessarily along the corridors or create any disturbance while classes are going on.

9. Class rooms, common rooms and other areas in the campus must be kept clean, pasting/distributing posters/banners/pamphlets, etc. without prior permission of the concerned authority is prohibited.
10. “Zero Tolerance” towards any kind of ragging, such acts shall invite legal actions against the offender.
11. Any complaint of unwelcome behaviour by our students in the neighbourhood shall be strictly dealt with.
12. Any kind of misconduct with the teachers, office staff and fellow students will be viewed seriously and strong action will be taken in such cases.
13. Defacing/damaging school infrastructure/fans, speakers overhead projectors including desks, benches, writing boards, chairs, tables, laboratory equipments, library books, computers, etc., shall amount to replacement/ payment of the cost.
14. Students/ parents/ guardians are free to meet the school authority for any clarification/information/counselling/guidance/assistance.
15. Students must regularly read the notices in the students' notice boards regarding various announcements, admission, stipends/ scholarships/registrations/routine/coaching classes, dates of fee payment, etc.
16. Submission of registration/examination forms, payment of school dues/examination fees/registration fees and other such important tasks must be completed within the stipulated date and time.
17. Examinations: it is mandatory for the students to appear in all the unit tests conducted on respective subjects. credit earned in these examinations will be taken into account while finalising the result of selection/ promotion examinations.

Rules and Regulation:

DRESS CODE:

All students are expected to attend classes dressed in the Higher Secondary Uniform. This uniform must be as per regulations and must be clean and worn smartly at all times even on the way to and from the campus. Students must wear their Identity Cards in the campus. Given that the Higher Secondary is co-educational, male and female students are to dress and behave so as to not cause offence to others.

Boys' uniform:

Fullsleeved white shirt, Full sleeve blue sweater, Bluepant, White socks, Black shoes, & School badge & School belt, Blue tie.

Girls' uniform:

Fullsleeved white kameez, Full sleeve blue sweater, Blue salwar, Blue dupatta, White socks, White ribbon, Black shoes & School badge.

Students are free to purchase their uniforms from a shop of their choice; the uniform must strictly adhere to the samples on display in the office.

In addition to the uniform, the following code should be adhered to:

1. Hair should be cut appropriately, combed and tidy.
2. Face rings, nose rings and lip rings are not to be worn. The wearing of earrings by boys is discouraged. Should boys wear earrings because of cultural tradition such students must have the written permission of the Principal.
3. Caps must not be worn in classrooms and should otherwise be removed deferentially when greeting a member of the Staff. Woollen caps may be worn during winter and when religious purposes require the shaving of the head.
4. The world has made wonderful strides in the development of mobile communication systems. However, given the purpose of Nehru Memorial Higher Secondary School, **mobile phones are not to be brought to the classroom.** If for various reasons you do bring a mobile to school, then you are expected to leave it in the Principal's office before class begins and collect it after school. Mobile phones in the possession of students on campus shall be confiscated and students penalized according to the rules of the institution. Similarly, **ear phones / iPods / MP3 / MP4 players / are not to be brought to the School.**
